**Training Message from Rich Britain KS & Western MO Coordinator:**

Dear SATERN Volunteer:

*The Emergency Disaster Services Office has been teaching an increasing number of Safe from Harm EDS Classes geared toward the emergency responder. The Emergency Disaster Services Office will be expanding its training to locations throughout Kansas and Missouri.*

*I know many of you live some distance from where the courses have been offered by EDS personnel. I have learned there exists another opportunity for Safe from Harm training. Many local Corps and Service Extension Facilities are also offering Safe from Harm Classes throughout the Division. While the classes offered by those groups may be slightly different from that offered by EDS personnel, they are still appropriate for our SATERN volunteers.*

*I do not currently receive the training schedules of these local facilities. I recommend that you contact your local Salvation Army Corps or Service Extension Office to see if they have a Safe from Harm Class in your local area.*

*If you take a Safe from Harm Class taught through a local Corps or Service Extension Facility, please send a copy of your certificate to the Salvation Army Emergency Disaster Services Office so the information may be placed in your on-line training profile in the Salvation Army National Database. A badge may then be issued if all appropriate courses and a clear background check are received. Please send a copy of the completed certificate by email to [kwm\\_eds@usc.salvationarmy.org](mailto:kwm_eds@usc.salvationarmy.org). There is an underscore between the kwm and eds. You may also mail a copy of the certificate to The Salvation Army Emergency Disaster Services Office, P.O. Box 412577, Kansas City, MO 64141. Please make sure and send me an email at [ksmosatern@kc.rr.com](mailto:ksmosatern@kc.rr.com) as to your completion of the course so I can verify your training was entered and a badge printed (if appropriate).*

*As information, "EDS Safe from Harm" training provides volunteers with training to assist those who work with children, youth, and vulnerable adults to remain in compliance with "EDS Safe from Harm" standards. Completion of this course, along with the course, "Introduction to Disaster Services" is required for all Salvation Army officers, staff, EDS and SATERN volunteers who wish to receive a Salvation Army ID badge. This badge is needed for Salvation Army deployment.*

This communication is to inform you that SATERN remains active and has now become fully integrated into **the Salvation Army's Emergency Disaster Services**.

We are asking for your input to help determine who's active in our Central Territory SATERN database, (pool of operators), and if you want to remain as an active SATERN members. We recently reviewed the SATERN roster and verified addresses with those in www.QRZ.com database. That is how you got this mailing. The database did not provide the date you first became a SATERN member, therefore you might be a new member receiving this communication. There were many errors in names and call signs. Sometimes we could fix the error and sometimes we could not. There was no way to confirm if phone numbers or e-mail addresses were correct, so they were dropped from the database. When this process is completed with your help, we should have a reliable database, one which will be kept current with your feedback via e-mail when you have changes in your information. If you know of someone who should have received this letter but did not, please forward a copy to him/her.

What needs to happen now is for you to fill out the questionnaire and mail it to: The Salvation Army CTHQ EDS, 10 West Algonquin Road Office A-209, Des Plaines, IL 6006-6006. This mailing has gone out to approximately 1,000

Central Territory members at a considerable cost for postage. Therefore we are asking for your support by providing return postage and any size envelope (you can fold the Questionnaire if you need to) to keep the cost to the Salvation Army as low as possible.

There will not be any further communications sent via the United States Postal Service. All future communications will be via e-mail, including your feedback from time to time.

If you are no longer interested or able to participate as a SATERN member at some level, simply discard this letter. SATERN members who do not respond will be placed on an "inactive" list. We expect to have a smaller roster but one that represents a true pool of trained operators who can assist in the Salvation Army's disaster response activities.

**AVAILABILITY:** Our SATERN group is composed of a diverse group of amateurs. In order to assess our SATERN response capabilities, we need to have current information about the response capabilities and interests of each SATERN member. Please check which of the following descriptions best fit where you see yourself today.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ I have the time, communication gear, and physical stamina to deploy locally, or out of town for a 2 week period. I understand that any field deployment requires having a current Salvation Army I.D. Badge.
  
2. \_\_\_\_\_ I have the time, communication gear, and physical stamina just for single day of local deployment. I understand that any field deployment requires having a current Salvation Army I.D. Badge.

3. \_\_\_\_ I can serve best from my home station handling traffic or acting as a net control station on \_\_\_\_ HF, on \_\_\_\_ VHF/UHF. A Salvation Army I.D. Badge is not required for this level.

4. \_\_\_\_ Please remove my name/call from the SATERN roster. I understand that I will not be receiving any more communication from SATERN unless I reapply in the future to become a SATERN member.

**TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:** All Deployable Emergency Disaster Services/SATERN personnel require a Salvation Army I.D. Badge. To obtain this I.D. Badge, a person must complete the two (2) listed courses **AND** complete a Criminal Background Investigation. The Salvation Army **DOES NOT** check credit history unless the individual is directly involved with Salvation Army finances.

- Introduction to The Salvation Army's Emergency Disaster Services Training Program (4 Hours)
- Salvation Army's Safe From Harm (3 Hours) (training to recognize vulnerable individuals and how to report abuse, neglect and/or exploitation of such individuals)

These courses are offered throughout the Central Territory on a regular basis. You can locate Emergency Disaster Services Training by surfing to [www.disaster.salvationarmyusa.org](http://www.disaster.salvationarmyusa.org) and clicking the TRAINING BUTTON then clicking the UPCOMING TRAINING. Upcoming training programs can be viewed by the state that they are offered in. Attending any training program in any state, division, or territory is accepted across the Salvation Army's Emergency Disaster Services units throughout the United States of America.

**STRIKE TEAM (New):** Would you be interested in becoming a member of a small, **highly trained team** of operators that, when asked, would be deployed at the very beginning of the disaster response? This group would establish preliminary communications, assist in gathering information about the situation to aid in the disaster response planning, and help set up the Salvation Army Command Center in the affected area. This group would be deployed by Central Territory HQ to anywhere in the territory. The Central Territory includes Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wisconsin.

Details for this Strike Team are in the development stage.

**FUTURE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES:** There is some consideration being given to holding SATERN training activities at the Central Territory Headquarters (THQ). These activities would be designed to supplement training at the division level but not replace such training. These activities would provide training opportunities for those members whose local division does not

currently have an active SATERN group. The specific topics would be determined by the needs of those members who express an interest in such training. Please check the statement(s) below that fit(s) your situation.
